- 1. Looked After Children and previously looked after children (as hereinafter defined);
- 2. children living in the priority admission area with a sibling attending the school or partner junior school;
- 3. children of staff currently employed by the school;
 a) where the member of staff has been employed at the school for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made, and/or

b) the member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage.

- 4. children living in the priority admission area;
- 5. Children living outside the priority admission area with a sibling attending the school or partner junior school.
- 6. remaining applications.

In the event of oversubscription within any of the above criteria, priority will be determined by straight line distance from home to school, those living closest being given the highest priority.
