Do you know that Essex Police have worked on cases of paedophiles grooming groups of children on these games?

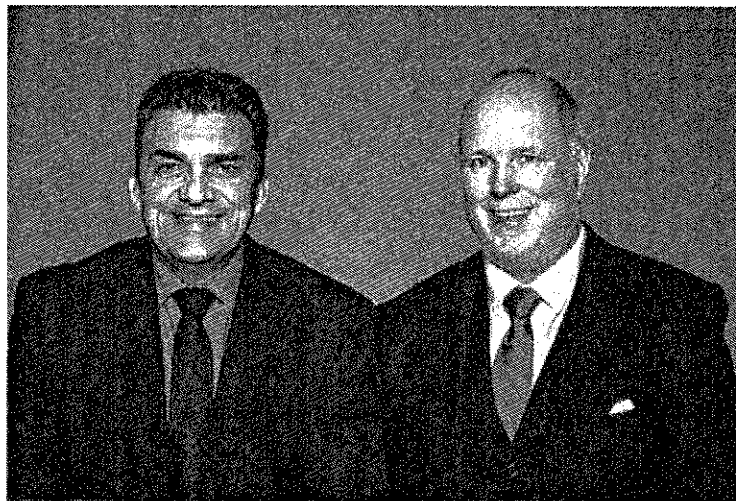
Do you know how gang culture and radicalisation online affects your child?
