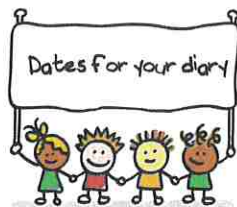

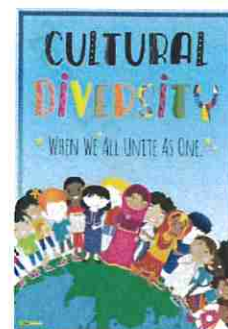

### **School Crossing Patrol on Gloucester Avenue**
