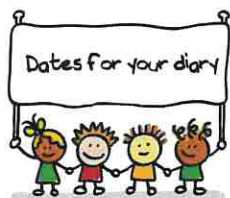

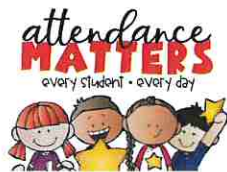
Congratulations In March, all the children in Year 1 and 2 children entered a national Primary Engineer competition titled 'If you were an engineer what would you do?'
