Phonemes we have learnt this week –

	<p>Pronunciation Phrase – ff Open your lips a little; put your teeth on your bottom lip and push the air out to make the sound ffff ffff</p> <p>Digraph (ff) – two letters, one sound</p>		<p>Pronunciation Phrase – ll Open your mouth a little; put your tongue up to the top of your mouth, behind your teeth, and press llll</p> <p>Digraph (ll) – two letters, one sound</p>
	<p>Pronunciation Phrase – ss Show your teeth and let the s hiss out ssssss</p> <p>Digraph (ss) – two letters, one sound</p>		<p>Pronunciation Phrase – j Pucker your lips and show your teeth use your tongue as you say jjj</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Formation Phrase – j All the way down the jellyfish. Dot on its head.</p> </div>
